

FAQ's: Activity Days: 2022

Q – Is food supplied or available at the activity day?

A – No – please can all participants bring Packed Lunch and Water Bottles. We will have a Refreshment Station to allow refill of water and squash throughout the events.

Q – Can parents attend the days? And Can they Take Part?

A- Yes, all parents are welcome to come along with their Paying Child at no cost. Parents and Other Adults can take part, but youth will have priority on all activities.

Q – Can my son/daughter bring a friend or sibling not in scouting?

A – Yes, however they will need to still register and completed the Booking Form in the same way as a Member of Dorset Scouts would. When they book, please enter the same scout group with (friend Of _____) added in the description.

Q – How will we make sure adult ratio's and safety for all children in maintained?

A – All activities will have a full risk assessment completed and will make sure the appropriate number of adults on each activities meet rations for all safety and safeguarding concerns in line with Scouting Guidance. All members of the Organizing team are fully First Aid Trained and hold any relevant qualifications for the day.

Q – Can Leaders Attend and Take Part?

A - Yes, all leaders are welcome to come along with if they have members of their groups attending. Parents and Other Adults can take part, but youth will have priority on all activities.

We would appreciate support from any leaders attending who may be able to assist with covering breaks from instructors and organizers.

Q – What Clothing should I wear?

A – This is variable, We strongly recommend that members please wear something identifying them as a Scouting member, This could be Uniform Tops, Scout Group T-Shirts and Necker's. But most importantly can everyone please be prepared for the British Weather and dress appropriately for the day, and forecast. (Limited Covered areas will be available on site)

Q – Are all activities suitable for all?

A – No, due to the nature of some of the activities they will have size or age restrictions, however each participant, never mind their age will have a selection on each day.

Q – Can we Camp during the weekends?

A – Water Activity Days has no camping availability, However each of the Land Activity Weekends has camp site available. These can be booked by Sections or Groups directly with the relevant camp sites. Just let them know your coming along for the Activity Days.

Q – When will I have to pay?

A – Groups will be sent a list of Participants the week before each event, and then invoiced in full for all participants and dates in September. Please when you book arrange payment with your section at the earliest opportunity. Payments cannot be taken on the day, or paid direct to Dorset Scouts. Payments must be via your local scout group.

Q – How Long do I have to confirm my booking?

A – Booking for each event closes 2 weeks before each start date. Please make sure you are booked up in time as late booking may not be accepted or possible.
